NO RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ALLOWED IN TRANSMISSION CORRIDOR

Dear Neighbor,

New York Transco and its contractors are actively constructing the Rock Tavern to Sugarloaf Project (RTS), an electric transmission line and station project, in an existing transmission corridor through New Windsor, Hamptonburgh, Blooming Grove, and Chester, NY. Our crews have been encountering recreational vehicles in the electric transmission corridor, particularly in the southern portion of our project. Recreational vehicles – ATVs, UTVs, etc. – are an incompatible use in and around electric transmission assets.

New York Transco and our contractors working on the RTS project are committed to the safety of our crews and neighbors, as well as the protection of the surrounding lands.

We are monitoring the corridor for recreational vehicle use and other incompatible corridor activities. Anyone found to be operating an ATV, UTV, dirt bike, or other motorized vehicles in the corridor will be subject to police action.

If you observe this type of activity in the corridor, we kindly request that you notify the local police and/or contact our team toll-free at 800.314.4236 with the date, time, location, and any other descriptive information about the vehicle or rider. Your identity will be kept confidential.
