Rock Tavern to Sugarloaf Project Activity Continues

Thank you for your continued cooperation as New York Transco (Transco) constructs the Rock Tavern to Sugarloaf Upgrade Project (RTS). RTS includes the replacement of a 12-mile 115,000 volt (115kV) electric transmission line and work at the connecting substations in New Windsor and Chester. RTS will help New York meet key environmental and economic goals by facilitating clean energy.

Project Update:

Transmission Line: Crews will soon complete the remaining work on new transmission structures. The last conductor wire pull is scheduled for mid-April.

Substation: Crews continue working at the 115kV Sugarloaf Substation and 138kV Switching Station in Chester. All Major equipment has been delivered and work will continue into late spring/summer.

Restoration:

Crews are starting restoration activities on the completed areas of the project. The transmission corridor and access points are restored following construction, including planting of low-growing vegetation, grasses, etc. Any plantings need to meet NERC and FERC regulations for safety, operability, and maintenance. Landscaping plans will be developed as needed. The RTS Team will continue working with agricultural operators on restoration.
