Rock Tavern to Sugarloaf Upgrade Project Energization

September 2023



Please accept this update from the New York Transco (Transco) on the Rock Tavern to Sugarloaf Upgrade Project (RTS). RTS includes the replacement of a 115,000 volt (115kV) transmission line, connecting existing electrical substations in New Windsor and Chester. RTS will help New York meet key environmental and economic goals by facilitating the flow of clean energy.

Project Update:

Since July 2020, Transco has worked with local communities,

neighbors, state officials, regulators, and other interested parties along the RTS project route. Construction on the RTS started June 2022, and this summer crews completed and energized the new, modern transmission monopole structures and lines and the rebuilt substation in Chester, strengthening the electric grid in Orange County. Crews recently completed removing project access road and project restoration.*

*Temporary erosion control measures such as green compost filter socks and silt fences may remain in place in some locations until revegetation occurs.
