NO VEHICLES ALLOWED IN TRANSMISSION CORRIDOR RESTORATION SITES

Dear Neighbor,

New York Transco and our contractors have been encountering a recurring problem with motorized vehicles and unauthorized access into areas that have been restored on the Rock Tavern to Sugarloaf Project (RTS). RTS is an electric transmission line and station project in an existing transmission corridor through New Windsor, Hamptonburgh, Blooming Grove, and Chester, NY. RTS recently began restoring areas of the transmission corridor where construction is complete.

RTS is obligated to restore areas after construction, including removing access roads, restoring existing grades, and seeding disturbed areas to promote the re-growth of vegetation.

Safety: Safety of our crews and neighbors, as well as the protection of the surrounding lands are our top priorities. Cars, trucks, ATVs, UTVs, dirt bikes, etc. — are an incompatible use in and around electric transmission assets, and the destruction of areas that have been recently restored may lead to prosecution.
