Dear Neighbors,

New York Transco and our contractors have been encountering a recurring problem with motorized vehicles and unauthorized access into our active construction sites for the Rock Tavern to Sugarloaf Project (RTS). RTS is an electric transmission line and station project in an existing transmission corridor through New Windsor, Hamptonburgh, Blooming Grove and Chester, NY. Construction began in June 2022 and is slated for completion by end of year 2023.

Safety of our crews and neighbors, as well as the protection of the surrounding lands are our top priorities. Last fall we sent notices reminding area neighbors that vehicles – cars, trucks, ATVs, UTVs, dirt bikes, etc. – are an incompatible use in and around electric transmission assets, and that entry into our construction sites is not allowed.

We continue to monitor the corridor and our work areas for incompatible and trespassing activities. Activity on our temporary construction road like the one captured in the picture below are expressly prohibited and are subject to police action. If you observe this type of activity in the corridor, we kindly request that you notify the local police and/or contact our team toll-free at 800.314.4236 with the date, time, location and any other descriptive information about the vehicle or operator. Your identity will be kept confidential.
